- Highlights and Overview of SpEd programming Laura Neenan
 - SpEd: 68 students on IEP (25% of all students)
 - Successes:
 - Case management and relationship building
 - Administration of MAP testing
 - Training of all staff to use strengths-based language
 - Goals:
 - Participation rubric. to shift engagement based on students' strengths.
 - Small group instruction. targeted interventions for students with IEPs.
 - o ELL: 41 students (16%) Formerly identified.
 - Successes:
 - Case management and relationship building
 - Staff being trained on 'economy of language' when providing written directions. (making sure that it's all clear, especially for those whose language is)
 - Goals:
 - Gathering more Assessment Data
 - Teacher training and focus on in-class supports
- School Leader Report:
 - Kevin Olusola from Pentatonix visiting 8th graders March 11.
 - Opening the School March 22 for hybrid learning.



- 123 Students opted in
 - Day is determined by Ensemble.
 - T/TH: 65 students, W/F: 58 students
- COVID Testing is lined up
- COVID Preparation:
 - Additional Staff (Part-time)- to ensure that COVID protocols are being followed. (Not in the budget, but with staff changes, will still be net positive)
 - Deep cleaning
 - PPE
 - Classroom /Art supplies
 - Equipment for concurrent teaching
 - Professional Development
- o Enrollment:
 - 67 6th grade (+1)
 - 99 7th grade (+1)
 - 99 8th grade
- Student recruiting update
 - Targeted schools: Focusing on 16 schools from which we've gotten students in the past; students that have shorter commutes.
 - Having Meet and Greet with those schools next week.
 - Sending Admissions Dashboard to give prospective families a flavor of the school
 - Doing professional development for some teachers from target schools; teaching those teachers how to do arts-based teaching.
 - Recruiting numbers are below previous years' numbers. Lots of NYC schools are experiencing this.

- Key issues:
 - MAP testing
 - Reopening
 - Making sure there's professional development. Focus will be Math.

• Finance Committee Report

- Jan was uneventful. We looked at it vs the amended budget.
- We were slightly behind budget (Jan) because of facilities
- We are generally ahead because of SpEd student participation
 - \$75K ahead of budget- this includes non-use of COVID contingency money
 - May use this with PPE and additional staff- Requires further conversation.
 - \$134K Contingency dollars: if we used it, we'd still have positive performance vs our budget.
- We are in the "Excellent" category according to SUNY's financial assessment.
- o If we use PPP money, we'll convert it to a grant.
